Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services

Starting **January 1, 2023**, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will cover Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy provided by:

- Licensed Behavioral Analyst (LBA), or
- Certified Behavioral Analyst Assistant (CBAA) under the supervision of an LBA.

Who can get ABA?

Children/youth under the age of 21 with a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder and/or Rett Syndrome. If you think you are eligible to get ABA services, talk to your provider about this service. UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will work with you and your provider to make sure you get the service you need.

The ABA services include:

- Assessment and treatment by a physician, licensed behavioral analyst, or certified behavior analyst assistant,
- Individual treatments delivered in the home or other setting,
- Group adaptive behavior treatment, and
- Training and support to family and caregivers.
